TrainingMaker was created to reduce the time and errors involved in generating course set-ups, instructor contracts, and educational agreements. Rocky Knoll Technologies designed this customized, Microsoft Access based, database for North Carolina community colleges. As a result, this work-flow tool will significantly reduce re-work due to human errors, as well as the time required to set up classes.

TrainingMaker is based on the Microsoft Access 2007 Database Application. Access provides a familiar platform for users to hit the ground running using the features of TrainingMaker, as opposed to learning a new way of using a database. TrainingMaker comes as an Executable that includes the Microsoft Access 2007 runtime module. This allows you to use TrainingMaker even if you don't have Microsoft Office 2007 or any Microsoft Office Products at all.
